Steady feet made of steel ensure the slicer's high degree of stability – furthermore, they provide a unique design, which sticks to the clean Bauhaus lines of the other ritter-appliances. Despite the rather small size, the inclined position of the pressure plate does ensure easy slicing.

Food slicer unica³ is driven by a 65 W eco motor, at 20 % reduced power consumption but 50 % increased engine efficiency compared to the previous model.

The two-finger switch-on safety system, switch for intermittent and continuous operation, detachable carriage and the four feet made of steel make this food slicer meet high standards.

Thanks to the bayonet quick-acting lock the blade may be taken off without tools for cleaning.
